

ALEXANDER'S KINGDOM DIVIDED TOWARD THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN

Daniel 8:8

When the “he goat”(Grecia – vs:21) AKA the “rough goat” was very great, the great horn(Alexander) was broken, and for it came up four notable ones towards the “four winds of heaven”

NOTE: “four winds of heaven” = the “four quarters of the earth”, which = West, North, East, South (Jeremiah 49:36)

NOTE: During Alexander’s greatness, at the age of only 33, after having ruled Greece for 8 years, he died of a drunken debauchery and his 2 sons and 1 brother Philip were murdered. Within 20 years, the kingdom was divided into 4 by his 4 leading generals

THE 4 LEADING GENERALS AND THEIR TERRITORIES WERE AS FOLLOWS:

WEST: Cassander

Macedon/Greece

NORTH: Lysimachus

Thrace/Asia Minor

(Eastern Europe/Western Asia)(AKA Eurasia/where Constantinople is today)(Turkey occupies this area)

Bosphorus (spelled Bosphorus today)= waterway located in northwestern [Turkey](#).

It forms part of the continental boundary between [Europe](#) and [Asia](#).

It’s the world’s narrowest strait used for international navigation

Hellespont = (AKA the Dardanelles) = the boundary between Europe in the northwest and Asia to the southeast

EAST: Seleucus

Babylon

Persia

Syria

SOUTH: Ptolemy

Egypt

And all the adjacent countries

NOTE: In order to be considered the King of the West, North, East, or South, you had to be occupying one of these 4 territories of Alexander’s original divided kingdom

NOTE: The terminology “king of the north”, “king of the south” ONLY REFERS to Alexander’s divided Empire
